MARÍA VICTORIA SERNA BOSSEL IS A PROMINENT VISUAL ARTIST AND CULTURAL MANAGER. BORN IN 1964, SHE GRADUATED AS A DRAWING TEACHER (1982) AND STUDIED FINE ARTS IN ARGENTINA, COMPLEMENTING HER TRAINING WITH SPECIALIZATIONS IN ACTING, SET DESIGN, AND CHARACTERIZATION.

TO FURTHER HER ARTISTIC TRAINING AND CAREER, SHE LIVED IN MADRID AND MÁLAGA, AND SINCE 2010 HAS RESIDED IN BARCELONA, WHERE SHE OBTAINED A MASTER'S DEGREE IN RESTORATION AND CONSERVATION OF OLD MASTER PAINTINGS AND TRAINING AS AN ART CURATOR. IN 2019, SHE FOUNDED THE IMAGINARTE GALLERY IN BARCELONA, A CREATIVE SPACE FOR CULTURAL INTEGRATION THAT ORGANIZES EXHIBITIONS, WORKSHOPS, AND INTERNATIONAL ART FAIRS. UNDER HER DIRECTION, IMAGINARTE PROMOTES BOTH ESTABLISHED AND EMERGING NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL ARTISTS WITH AN INCLUSIVE AND INTERCULTURAL APPROACH. SHE HAS RECEIVED HONORABLE MENTIONS AND NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL AWARDS THAT HAVE OPENED DOORS FOR HER WORLDWIDE. AS AN EDUCATOR AND SET DESIGNER, SHE APPLIES A NARRATIVE AND THEATRICAL SENSIBILITY TO HER PAINTING, REFLECTING HER EXTENSIVE ARTISTIC TRAINING. SELECTED IN 2023/2024 BY THE MEAM (MUSEUM OF CONTEMPORARY ART OF SPAIN).

SHE IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF SPANISH ARTISTIC ASSOCIATIONS, HAVING BEEN RECOGNIZED BY THE SPANISH ASSOCIATION OF PAINTERS AND SCULPTORS (AEPE), A TESTAMENT TO HER PRESENCE ON THE SPANISH CULTURAL SCENE.

INTERNATIONALLY, MS. DE LA SERNA HAS BEEN APPOINTED BRAND AMBASSADOR FOR THE SPAIN BRAND AT THE QATAR INTERNATIONAL ART FESTIVAL, ACTIVELY PARTICIPATING IN THE PROMOTION OF SPANISH ART AT THIS GLOBAL EVENT. SHE ALSO ACTS AS A CULTURAL AMBASSADOR IN VARIOUS INTERNATIONAL FORUMS, CHANNELING INITIATIVES THAT STRENGTHEN CULTURAL TIES BETWEEN SPAIN AND OTHER COUNTRIES.

WITH THIS EXPERIENCE, BROAD INTERNATIONAL VISION, AND COMMITMENT TO CULTURAL PROMOTION, VICTORIA EMBODIES THE PROFILE OF A DIPLOMATIC AND CREATIVE PROFESSIONAL WHO CAN FORGE ARTISTIC CONNECTIONS BETWEEN SPAIN AND THE WORLD.



ANTONIO OCAÑA



Antonio Ocaña is a contemporary artist whose work is distinguished by an intimate, symbolic, and emotionally charged aesthetic. In "The Twilight of Tears," he explores the idea of pain transformed, representing the moment when sadness fades and gives way to a new inner light. The "Dreams" collection, on the other hand, delves into a more dreamlike and hopeful universe, where the images convey introspection, sensitivity, and a poetic perspective on humanity. Both projects reflect a profound emotional commitment and an authentic and personal artistic expression.

Uriel Barragan Bouler



BOULER is a master of a wide range of artistic techniques. He works with acrylics on canvas, wood, and walls, and in the field of printmaking, he has developed pieces using woodcut, linocut, digital media, artistic screen printing, and mixed media techniques such as gold leaf and digital animation, always exploring new visual languages.

His career includes more than 35 exhibitions, both group and solo, in various states of Mexico, such as Guadalajara, Coahuila, Mexico City, Cancún, and Querétaro. Internationally, his work has been exhibited in countries such as France, Italy, Turkey, Canada, Spain, Australia, and Cuba.

Muralism and his workshops are part of his community-based artistic work. BOULER has created 7 murals in the Jalatlaco neighborhood, one of the most emblematic in Oaxaca, in addition to more than 20 murals in different regions of the state, and 8 murals in foreign countries, always carrying with him the symbols of Zapotec and Mexican culture, engaging in dialogue with the communities.

In 2025, he received a Distinction Award for Professional Merit from the municipality of Oaxaca de Juárez, as part of the city's 493rd anniversary celebrations.

Bouler doesn't just paint canvases and walls; he builds bridges between cultures, times, and territories. His artistic vision is a narrative force that honors the past and projects itself toward the future.





CLAUDIO ARGENTO



Before being an artist, he was an architect, and before being an architect, he was an artist. Of Italian-Argentine origin, this artist designs and builds imaginary worlds, and the architect makes them possible. He comes from a family of musicians, so he was connected to art from a young age. His works are characterized by simplicity and contemplation. His exhibitions have already toured more than 150 cities worldwide.

With the poetic sensibility of a researcher and in clear harmony with his existential balance, Claudio discards all preamble and appearances, letting himself be guided by the simplicity that, in some way, permeates his work and his person. His style is eminently minimalist; he plays with forms and colors in a space where chance does not exist and each brushstroke is planned after a process of research and design.


DANIEL CAVOLO



Daniel Cavolo is a contemporary artist whose work is characterized by a strong emotional charge and an intimate perspective on the human figure. His watercolors stand out for their soft, atmospheric palette, dominated by tones that convey calm, nostalgia, and sensitivity. In them, Cavolo explores portraits and everyday scenes with a poetic, almost ethereal approach that invites the viewer to pause and observe the details. The fluid technique of watercolor allows him to create transparencies, light, and shadow that lend depth to his compositions, resulting in delicate, expressive works full of personality.

EMMA FERRA



The artwork reveals a scene of both oblivion and companionship. The teddy bear lying on the ground evokes the abandonment and fragility of childhood; the children's toys represent vestiges of lost games and memories.

This work arises from the need to reframe the abandonment experienced by many children. I explore how, even in that void, subtle gestures of care emerge, restoring meaning. Through this composition, I sought to represent both the desolation of helplessness and the possibility of finding solace in the unexpected. The blue sky serves as an emotional counterpoint, introducing a glimmer of hope and openness in the face of the devastation of oblivion, as we see a small mouse lying on its back; it appears as a gesture of companionship and care, showing that abandonment is not always total. Overall, the work invites the viewer to pause in the face of oblivion, to empathize with what has been left behind, and to believe in the restorative capacity of the company, since attention and care towards the other are acts that rebuild identities; caring in this sense is a form of resistance against helplessness.


FABÍANA ORTEGA

Through her mosaics, Ortega creates landscapes, scenes, and emotions that invite contemplation, transmitting movement and light on static surfaces. Her technique, both meticulous and intuitive, reveals a creative energy that turns the ordinary into something monumental. The artist understands mosaic not only as an aesthetic discipline but also as a tool for social and cultural connection, capable of generating identity and collective memory. With each piece, Fabiana Ortega reaffirms the power of art to transform spaces and perspectives, establishing herself as a creator who brings mosaic art to new artistic dimensions.

FEBLES CERÎANÎ



In the intimate world of POCOSITIO, every object—books, oil paintings, ceramics, puppets, and handcrafted pieces—holds an echo of memory and craft. There, among silent treasures, the master Febles Ceriani welcomes each visitor with the serenity of one who lives to paint and the warm smile of someone who seems to have known us forever. His connection to art began at the age of eight, when watercolor opened the door to a life dedicated to the visual. Later, he ventured into advertising and animation, expanding a visual language that would become profoundly personal.


His work, marked by a deliberately austere palette, favors reds, siennas, and aged ochres, tones that evoke ports, weathered wood, and horizons that hold the roots of the South. His career has led him to exhibit in Argentina, New York, Spain, France, and Italy, always with that blend of skill, sensitivity, and pictorial honesty that defines his vision. Febles doesn't just paint landscapes: he constructs places where memory and time converse.

Trained under the influence of Joaquín Torres García's School of the South, Febles Ceriani incorporates the principles of universalist constructivism into his work: order, balance, and structure.

His compositions reflect this heritage, where each form engages with a profound meaning and each color responds to an internal order. His painting keeps the Uruguayan constructivist tradition alive, reinterpreting it through his personal experience and unique lyricism.

HÉCTOR LÓPEZ MOÑÍZ



This draftsman, sculptor, and painter loves what he does and enjoys doing it; even as a child, he sculpted his mother's bars of soap, though these would eventually end up as suds in a sink, while at the same time he was exploring drawing and the study of the human figure.

He was born in Uruguay but had to leave his country in the 1970s due to the prevailing dictatorship and settled in Spain, where he studied Fine Arts and received a scholarship to travel to Paris. During his time in France and for some years afterward, he decided to move permanently to Barcelona, where he has resided ever since, completing his training as a marble sculptor at the Barcelona School of Fine Arts.

This artist demonstrates a unique sensitivity for fusing the everyday with the symbolic, employing traditional techniques such as colored pencil and ink, but with a profoundly contemporary perspective. His work explores the representation of human psychology through architectural forms or mental landscapes. Her visual metaphors speak to us of the body as a dwelling, of the ravages of time, of the intimacy that resides in a mental corner filled with memories of a personal history, perhaps questioning to what extent what we inhabit inhabits us, and how the fragility of the body or the habitat has shaped our past and our identity. Undoubtedly, a work imbued with a very solid visual poetics.

JOSE BLESA




After many years of working with pencil, charcoal, and graphite, this Spanish landscape artist was born in Alcaniz, Teruel province, in 1959.

He surprises us with his new oil paintings and his innovative technique, which gives him a unique identity very close to that of his homeland. His works have already been exhibited in various national and international exhibitions.

This painter achieves the different tones and textures of his works by impregnating pigments extracted from the mines of his homeland—preferably lignite coal—with the oil paints he applies to the canvas, thus transforming the original colors into others burned by the charcoal. This original composition demands meticulous technical work, as each brushstroke is unique and unrepeatable.

His works, which have been exhibited in more than 16 international exhibitions, are now in private collections.





Luis Alava



This artist, born in Ecuador in 1995, has had drawing as an essential part of his life since childhood. He initially excelled at perspective and form, and over time, he transformed this skill into a passion. His primary focus is portraiture, seeking to capture gestures and emotions. For Luis, drawing is personal expression, a fundamental part of his life, an activity that constantly accompanies him and that he feels increasingly necessary, and with which he aspires to establish himself in the artistic community.

Regardless of the medium chosen, his work is characterized by a profound expressive realism, centered on monochromatic portraits. His precise handling of light and shadow is particularly noteworthy, lending volume and drama to each face and conveying subtle emotions and intense gazes. His use of charcoal allows him to explore strong contrasts and soft textures, achieving balanced and characterful compositions. Each piece reflects a constant quest to capture the human essence, beyond the physical, transforming portraiture into an intimate and personal means of expression that defines his artistic vision.

Born in Barcelona in 1963, he is a draftsman, illustrator, and photographer.

He trained at the Escola Massana in Barcelona. He holds a specialist degree in painting and mural techniques.

He has worked as an illustrator for Ediciones Lema and Océano, and is an illustrator for the International Association of Creative Writing Workshops in Barcelona.

"A painting requires mystery, a few ambiguities, and fantasy." With this philosophy, the artist creates his works, using his unique ability to capture, in just a few lines or colors, an image that conveys meaning from every possible perspective.

His work alternates between watercolors, acrylics, oils, and drawings created using the ancient three-color technique: black charcoal, sanguine, and white chalk on various colored supports.

MARY FRANCES ATTÍAS



A visual artist of Lebanese descent born in the Dominican Republic, Mary Frances has remained true to her early artistic vocation, moving fluidly through the worlds of literature, writing, and painting. She has trained with renowned curators and artists both locally and internationally. She holds a Master's degree in Photography, Theories, and Artistic Projects from PhotoEspaña. She is also a Systems Engineer with postgraduate studies in Foreign Trade, International Economics, and Human Resources. For many years, she worked in the corporate world, taking on various roles within her family's business industry. Among her many interests, she has taken workshops and seminars with distinguished professionals in screenwriting, film production, editing techniques, creative writing, lighting, digital processing, and the development of visual narratives. She has participated in collective and solo exhibitions in South and Central America, **Europe, the United Arab Emirates, the United States, and the Dominican Republic, where** she currently resides. Her work as a visual artist and screenwriter has been featured in important local and international media outlets. Her series "Fugaces", presented in Madrid (2021), was selected for the Foto Arica International Festival in Chile and has been exhibited in prestigious venues and galleries throughout the Dominican Republic. She received an Honorable Mention in "Andares de la Ciudad Colonial," a program aimed at promoting the artistic and urban heritage of Santo Domingo's historic district. She took part in the Photoimagen 2022 Festival with her short film "Un Salto al Vacío," within the "Women and Resistance" section, and was selected for the 2023 Image Biennial. She is a member of the International Federation of Photographic Art (FIAP) and of the local collective Fotogrupo, where she participates actively. She is the founder and director of TimeArt, a nonprofit organization that grants university scholarships to outstanding students and develops workshops, exhibitions, audiovisual projects, and other cultural programs that contribute to holistic education in the Dominican Republic. Her curiosity, sense of wonder toward nature, and reflections on the fragility of the human condition deeply permeate her photographic work. "My work generally maintains the presence of the landscape—understood from a highly ambiguous perspective—as a trigger to explore universal themes related to identity, memory, time, love, and death. I try to communicate how I experience the world through my images, creating a kind of shared diary."

MAX SANZ



Max Sanz, born on April 24, 1992, in the Sierra Norte region of Oaxaca, discovered his passion for the visual arts as a child. He trained at the Rufino Tamayo workshop and worked as an assistant in Fernando Sandoval's printmaking workshop, which allowed him to interact with prominent artists. He furthered his training with masters such as Barry Head and studied at the CEDART Miguel Cabrera and the Bauhaus University in Puebla.

Since the age of 13, he has participated in more than 60 group exhibitions and 50 solo exhibitions in countries such as France, Spain, China, the United States, Italy, Mexico, and Hungary. He has received grants from CONACULTA (the Mexican National Council for Culture and the Arts) and national awards in sculpture and painting. His work is part of several important collections both in Mexico and abroad.





MICHELE ARDITO



This Italian artist, born in Matera and currently living in Milan, holds a degree in modern literature with a focus on anthropology. He also worked as a stage collaborator and general director in the creation of dance-theater performances with the Italian-French Contemporary Dance Company "Cie Ezio Schiavulli."

He translates all this cultural background into his paintings. In his own words, "As a teenager, I discovered painting and explored the surreal possibilities it offered. I imagined traveling through the veins of leaves, along the bark of trees; my mind conjured up fantastic animals and anthropomorphic creatures in unreal landscapes and situations, and I reproduce all of that on the canvas."

His paintings are metaphors for the human condition or visions of reality transformed by his unconscious. His balanced compositions contrast with the surrealism of his images. Such detailed and precise figuration invites us to immerse ourselves in the artist's enigmatic dreamlike universe, as we gaze in rapt attention at his creations, which present us with scenarios, creatures, fantastical beings, and natural settings as real as they are disconcerting to our senses.

PEDRO BAOS



Pedro Baos employs the technique of the old Spanish classical painters, who rendered figures on their canvases with thin layers, one on top of the other, thus achieving textures characteristic of the great masters.

By mixing paint with varnishes, oils, mediums, and developing highly transparent painting techniques, the artist imbues his canvases with his own unique and personal atmosphere.

Pedro Baos explores a wide variety of subjects, avoiding a single theme. His art includes staircases, courtyards, streets, beaches, portraits—in short, any corner of the world that has captivated him with its allure. This is why each of his paintings is distinct, with its own unique appeal.


With his restless sensibility and the power of his brushes, the artist draws our attention to the chromatic appeal of rusty iron, damp stains on a wall, and rotting wood, as well as the light streaming through a window, piercing the darkness of a room, or the melancholic beauty in a child's gaze as they observe the world from a window. And when least expected, an explosion of vibrant colors takes the viewer's breath away.

From the time Pedro Baos began experimenting with color professionally in 1975 until the end of 2013, his work has come a long way. The painter's new direction leaves behind the surrealist patina of his studio paintings and consigns his quick landscape canvases to the past, delving into a more meditative and contemplative exploration of aesthetic beauty as he interprets it, with much more reflective and elaborate paintings.

RAOUDA HEJAZÎ



Raouda Hejazi's art is a testament to personal liberation and self-discovery, a path she has walked since childhood. Viewing creation as a source of healing and limitless expression, she pursued Fine Arts and Interior Design at George Washington University.

His works, exhibited in various museums, are now part of some of them and private collections around the world.






